THE CONDITION OF THE ABOVE OBLIGATION IS SUCH, THAT IF THE ABOVE BOUNDEN

shall well, truly and faithfully observe all the laws of this Commonwealth relating to his business of Inn or Tavern keeper, for which he has received a license from the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
