

LICENSE BOND.

Know all Men by these Presents, That we Matthew Adelsberg
George J. Schwaderer and Frank S. O'Hara of the
Township of Cresson of the County of Cambria
and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, are jointly and severally held and
bound unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the just and lawful sum
of Two Thousand Dollars, lawful money, to be paid to the said Common-
wealth, its certain attorneys, or assigns, to which payment well and truly to
be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, and each
of them, firmly, by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this Sixth day of
January, A. D. 1896

And, further, We do hereby empower the District Attorney of Cambria
County, or any other attorney of any court of record in the Commonwealth of
Pennsylvania, to appear for us in the Court of Common Pleas of any County in
Pennsylvania, and, after filing one or more declarations, to confess judgment
against us for the above penal sum, with costs of suit and release of all errors.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such

That, If the above bounden, Matthew Adelsberg
to whom a license to sell Spirituous, Vinous, Malt or Brewed Liquors, or any
admixture thereof, in quantities not exceeding one quart, has been granted,
shall faithfully observe all the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania re-
lating to the selling or furnishing Vinous, Spirituous, Malt or Brewed Liquors,
or any admixture thereof, and to pay all damages which may be recovered in
any action which may be instituted against him under the
provisions of any Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and
all costs, fines, and penalties which may be imposed upon him
under any indictment for violating the Act of Assembly, entitled "An Act to
Restrain and Regulate the Sale of Vinous and Spirituous, Malt or Brewed
Liquors, or any Admixture Thereof," approved the 13th day of May, A. D.
1887, or any other Act of Assembly relating to selling or furnishing liquors as
aforesaid, then this obligation to be void, else to be and remain in full force
and virtue.
