Q.-- What, if anything, did they say to you that they had signed? A.-- Quite a number of them declared that they did not know what they had signed.

Q.-- Did they state who requested them to sign it? A.-- They said they signed it at the shaft, one party told me that he had not signed it, nor had he authorized his name to be placed on there.
