

In the Court of Quarter Session of Cambria County Penn'a.

Interested parties being the continuance of the license

To the Honorable A. V. Barker, President Judge of  
the above named Court, at March Sessions 1896.

The petition of John Becher, prays your Honorable  
Court to grant him a license under the Acts of Assembly approved  
the 24th day of May 1887 and the 9th day of June 1891, to sell  
malt, brewed, and spirituous liquors at wholesale at his agency  
or store in the Borough of Gallitzin, in the County of Cambria and  
State of Pennsylvania, representing as follows:

1st That his name is John Becher, present residence Gallitzin  
Borough, Cambria County, Penn'a., where he has resided for *about*  
*29* years last past.

2nd. That the particular place for which a license is desired  
is a certain house situate in the Borough of Gallitzin, in said  
County of Cambria on ground of the P. R. R. Company, about two  
hundred feet West of the P. R. R. Station.

3rd. That your petitioner was born at *Allegheny Twp* in the  
County of *Cambria* and State of *Pennsylvania* on the *Second*  
day of *March* 18*57*

4th. That the name of the owner of the premises for which a  
license is desired is John Becher.

5th. That the place to be licensed is necessary for the  
accommodation of the public.

6th. That the applicant is not in any manner pecuniarily  
interested in the profits of the business conducted at any other  
place in said County where any of said liquors are sold or kept  
for sale.

7th. That the applicant is the only person in any manner  
pecuniarily interested in the business so asked to be licensed,
