THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the above bounden *John Bending* shall well, truly, and faithfully observe all the laws of this Commonwealth relating to the business of *inn* or *Tavern Keeper* keeper, for which he has received a license from the District Court of Cambria County, then this obligation to be void, else to be and remain in full force and virtue.
