And further, we do hereby empower the District Attorney of Cambria County to appear for us in the Court of Common Pleas of said county, and after filing declaration, to confess judgment against us for the above sum and costs of suit.

The conditions of the above obligations are, that if the above bounden *John A. Blair* shall well, truly and faithfully observe all the laws of this Commonwealth relating to his business of Tavern or Inn Keeper, for which he has received a license from the Court of Quarter Sessions of said County, then this obligation to be void, else to remain in full force and virtue.
