



To the Honorable U. V. Barker, President Judge of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County Pa.

March Sessions A.D. 1896.

The petitioner respectfully represents, that your petitioner is a citizen of United States, of good moral character, and temperate habits, desires to keep a Brewery to brew Malt liquors, and prays your Honorable Court to grant her a License under the laws of this Commonwealth for said Brewery and the sale of brewed or malt liquors or any admixture thereof at wholesale at said Brewery.

First. Your petitioner further represents, that the name of your petitioner is B. W. Blum, of the Borough of Carrolltown, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, and that she has resided on the premises asked to be licensed for more than forty years past.

2nd That the particular place for license where desired is a two story frame house 30 x 100 feet with an addition of 40 x 40 feet, situate in Carrolltown Borough, Cambria County, Penn^a fronting on Main Street, land of heirs of S. Schrock, deceased on the north, Church Street on the East, and Blum's Alley on the South. Said house has been licensed for forty years past.

3rd That your petitioner and applicant was born in Allegheny Township Cambria County Penn^a on the 9 day of April A.D. 1845.

4th The name of the premises where license is prayed for is B. W. Blum (in trust)

5. That the place prayed to be licensed is necessary for the accommodation of the public. (This provision does not apply to a brewer)

6. That your petitioner is not in any manner pecuniarily interested in the profits of the business conducted at any other place in said County where any of said liquors are sold or kept for sale.

7th That said applicant is not in any manner pecuniarily interested in the profits of the business conducted at any other place in said County where any of said liquors are sold or kept for sale, nor is she the owner
