Pennsylvania relating to the selling or furnishing of vinous, spirituous, malt or brewed liquors, or any admixtures thereof, and
shall pay all damages which may be recovered in any action which may be instituted against *him the said*
B. A. Blum under the provisions of any Act of
Assembly, and shall pay all costs, fines and penalties which may be imposed upon *him the said B.*
A. Blum under any indictment for violating the Act
of May 13th, 1887, entitled "An Act to restrain and regulate the sale of vinous and spirituous, malt or brewed liquors or
any admixtures thereof," or any other Act of Assembly relating to selling or furnishing liquors as aforesaid; then this
Obligation shall be void and of no effect, or else shall be and remain in full force and virtue.

do by these presents, empower *The District Attorney of Cambria County Pa*
or any other Attorney of any Court of Record of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to appear for us *B. A. Blum,*

therein and confess judgment against us *B. A. Blum Benjamin Wortner & Francis Fleck*
for the said penal sum, with cost of suit and release of all errors, and we *B. A. Blum Benjamin*
Wortner & Francis Fleck do hereby waive the right of inquisition on real estate, and all
laws exempting real or personal property from levy and sale on execution.
