Know all Men by these Presents, That we Charles J. Hoffman

residents of the County of Cambria and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, are jointly and severally held and bound unto the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in the just and lawful sum of Two Thousand Dollars, lawful money, to be paid to the said Commonwealth, its certain attorneys or assigns, to which payment well and truly to be made, we bind ourselves, our heirs, executors, and administrators, and each of them, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated this 7th day of January, A. D. 189

And, further, We do hereby empower the District Attorney of Cambria County, or any other attorney of any court of record in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to appear for us in the Court of Common Pleas of any County in Pennsylvania, and, after filing one or more declarations, to confess judgment against us for the above penal sum, with costs of suit and release of all errors.

The Condition of the Above Obligation is Such

That, If the above bounden, Charles J. Hoffman
of Johnstown Pa to whom a license to sell Spirituous, Vinous, Malt or Brewed Liquors, or any admixture thereof, in accordance with the Act of Assembly approved the 9th day of June, A. D. 1891, has been granted, shall faithfully observe all the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania relating to the selling or furnishing Vinous, Spirituous, Malt or Brewed Liquors, or any admixture thereof, and to pay all damages which may be recovered in any action which may be instituted against him under the provisions of any Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and all costs, fines, and penalties which may be imposed upon him under any indictment for violating the Act of Assembly, entitled "An Act to Restrain and Regulate the Sale of Vinous and Spirituous, Malt or Brewed Liquors, or any Admixture Thereof by Wholesale," approved the 9th day of June, A. D. 1891, or any other Act of Assembly relating to selling or furnishing liquors as aforesaid, then this obligation to be void, else to be and remain in full force and virtue.

Petitioner further state that each of said sureties is a bona-fide owner of real estate in the said county, worth, over and above all incumbrances, the sum of Two Thousand Dollars, and that it would sell for that much at public sale, and that said sureties, or either of them, are not engaged in the manufacture of Spirituous, Vinous, Malt or Brewed Liquors.

Your petitioner therefore prays that a license may be granted to him for one year, to sell at the place aforesaid, in accordance with this petition and said Act of Assembly. And as in duty bound, your petitioner will ever pray.
