

In the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County Penn'a.

To the Honorable A. V. Barker, President Judge of the above named Court, at March Sessions 1892.

The petition of Damas Lutz and Anton Lutz, trading and doing business under the firm name of D. Lutz & Son, praysyour Honorable Court to grant them a license under the Acts of Assembly approved the 24th day of May 1387 and the 9th day of June 1891, to sell malt, brewed, and spirituous liquors at wholesale at their agency or separate store in the Borough of Gallitzin, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, represents as follows: 1st The names and present address of your applicants are as follows:

Damas Lutz, Spring Garden Avenue, Allegheny City, Pennsylvania Anton Lutz, """"""" where they have resided for a period of thirty-six years. 2nd. The particular place for which a license is desired is a certain house situate in Gallitzin Borough, in said County of Cambria on ground of P.R.R.Co., about two hundred feet West of the P.R.R.Station.

3rd. That your petitioners were born and naturalized as follows:

Damas Lutz, Born in Germany, naturalized in the Court of Quarter Sessions of Alleghany County May 19th 1855.

Anton Lutz was born in 1853 at Pittsburg, Allegheny County Pa. 4th That the name of the owner of the premises for which license is desired is D. Lutz & Son.

5th. That the place to be licensed is necessary for the accommodation of the public.

6th. That the applicants are not in any manner pecuniarily interested in the profits of the business conducted at any other
