NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the above bounden

John Logue shall faithfully observe all the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, relating to the selling or furnishing of vinous, spirituous, malt or brewed liquors, or any admixtures thereof, and shall pay all damages which may be recovered in any action which may be instituted against him, the said John Logue under the provisions of any Act of Assembly, and shall pay all costs, fines and penalties which may be imposed upon him, the said John Logue under any indictment for violating the Act of May 13th, 1887, entitled "An Act to restrain and regulate the sale of vinous and spirituous, malt or brewed liquors, or any admixtures thereof," or any other Act of Assembly relating to selling or furnishing liquors as aforesaid; then this Obligation shall be void and of no effect, or else shall be and remain in full force and virtue.
