prays the Honorable Court to grant him a Wholesale License
to sell liquors, under the Act of Assembly approved the 9th day of June, A. D.
1891, and respectfully sheweth:

1. The name of your petitioner John J. McCann

and his present address is Lilly, Pa.

in Cambria County, where he has resided, 15 Years.

2. The particular place for which License is prayed for and desired, is
a two story frame building 30x36ft. fronting on Railroad St. adjoin-
ing property of F. A. Thompson on the East and an alley on the West & South
in the Borough of Lilly in said county.

3. The applicant for license is a citizen of the United States was
born in Dalry Scotland on March 24th, 1866

and was naturalized at Etensburg, Cambria Co., Pa., on the 7th of
Dec., 1887.

4. The name of the owner of the premises prayed to be licensed is F. A.
