NOW THE CONDITION OF THIS OBLIGATION IS SUCH, That if the above bounden Julius Nager shall faithfully observe all the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, relating to the selling or furnishing of vinous, spirituous, malt or brewed liquors, or any admixtures thereof, and shall pay all damages which may be recovered in any action which may be instituted against said Julius Nager under the provisions of any Act of Assembly, and shall pay all costs, fines and penalties which may be imposed upon said Julius Nager under any indictment for violating the Act of May 13th, 1887, entitled "An Act to restrain and regulate the sale of vinous and spirituous, malt or brewed liquors, or any admixtures thereof," or any other Act of Assembly relating to selling or furnishing liquors as aforesaid; then this Obligation shall be void and of no effect, or else shall be and remain in full force and virtue.

AND FURTHER, Julius Nager, H. B. Kirkpatrick and W. A. Luther Jr. do, by these presents, empower District Attorney of Cambria County, Pennsylvania or any other Attorney of any Court of Record of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, to appear for Julius Nager, H. B. Kirkpatrick and W. A. Luther Jr. therein, and confess judgment against Julius Nager, H. B. Kirkpatrick and W. A. Luther Jr. for the said penal sum, with cost of suit and release of all errors; and Julius Nager, H. B. Kirkpatrick and W. A. Luther Jr. do hereby waive the right of inquisition on real estate, and all laws exempting real or personal property from levy and sale on execution.
