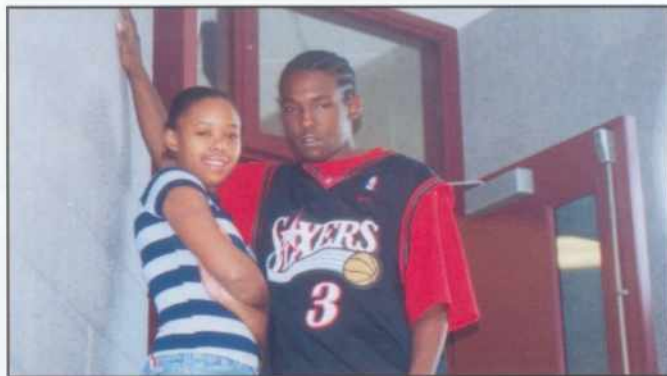

Dedication

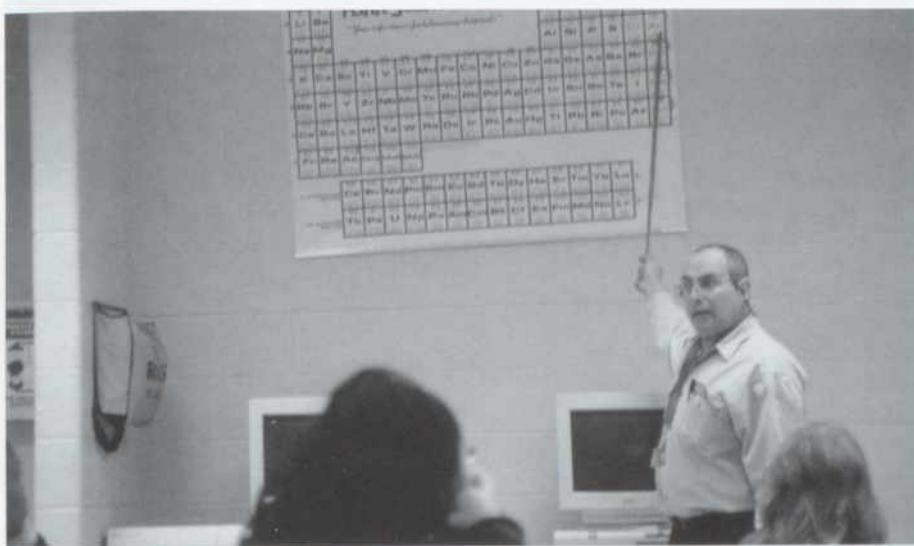

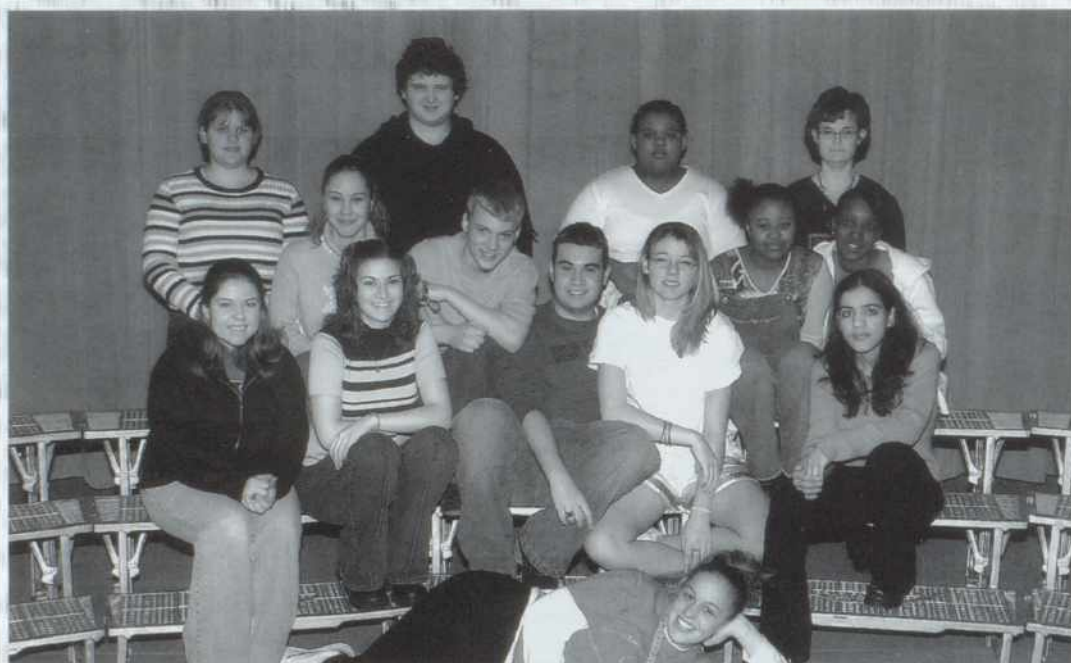

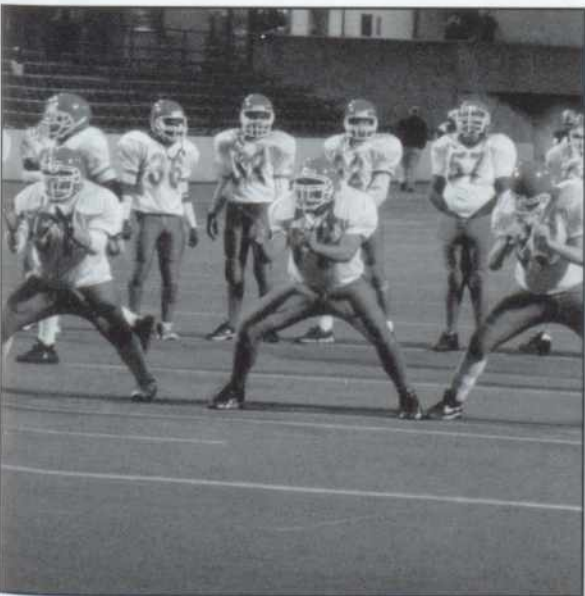

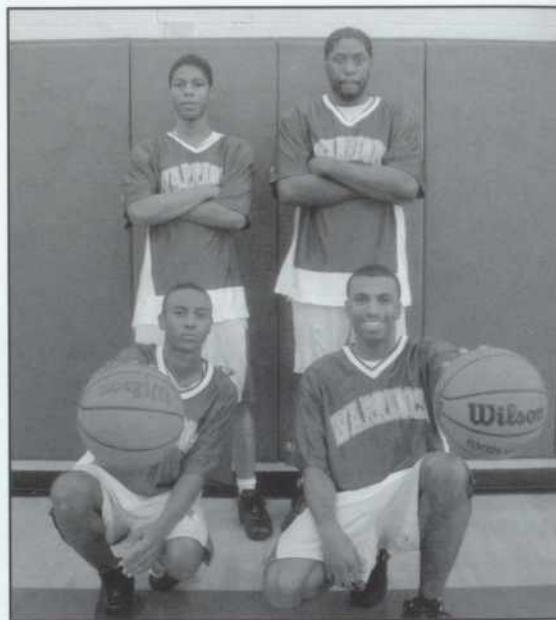

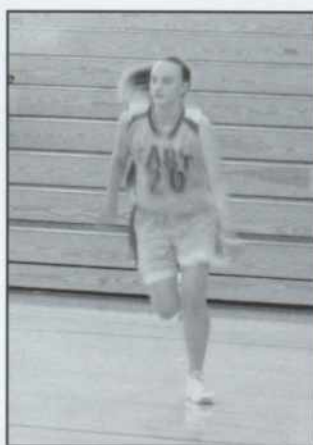
