A year away from home in a new place.

East High school was privileged enough to have exchange students from all over the world this year. Students came from countries like Japan, Germany, Italy, Vietnam, South Korea, and Brazil. East students had an opportunity to get to know these students well and benefit from their world experiences. These students took the time to sit down and talk about some of the things they experienced while they were in the United States:


East Football Field Dedicated to "Duke" Detzel
