

Petition for Naturalization, Under Act.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF THE COUNTY
OF CAMBRAY at a Court helden in and for said County, the 15th day
of January A.D. 1900.

The petition of John Beirosh, a native of
Austria, now residing in Patton Borough,
the County of Cambria, and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully sheweth:

That your petitioner arrived in the United States of America to
wit: at the port of New York, in the State of New York
on or about the 6th day of February, A.D. 1892 being
then under the age of eighteen years, to wit: of the age of Twelve
years, that he has resided within the limits and jurisdiction of the
United States for five years last past, and that during more than
three years last past, it has been his intention to become a citizen
of the United States; that he has never borne any hereditary title,
or been of any of the orders of nobility in Austria
from whence he came. He therefore prays that he may become a cit-
izen of the United States, and he will ever pray so.
