To the honorable judges of the Court of Common
Pleas of Cambria county at December Term 1833

Richard Bennett residing in Cambria Township
in the county aforesaid asks leave to make
registry in accordance with the second section of the
act of Congress passed the 14th day of April AD 1802
that he is a native of that part of Great Britain
called Wales that he was born in the County of
Montgomery about the year 1787 that he
emigrated to this country in 1824 arrived at
Norfolk Va. July the same year that he
owes allegiance to the King of Great Britain
Ireland & Wales that he has always been
called by the Christian and Surname of
Richard Bennett and that it is Bone fide
his intention to become a citizen of the
United States and he hereby renounces
and abjures all allegiance to every ^{foreign} prince
potentate state and sovereignty whatever
and more particularly the King of Great
Britain Ireland and Wales to whom he
was heretofore a subject
