at a Court holden in and for said County, the *ninth* day of *September* A. D. 1896.

The petition of *George Calis*, a native of *Austria*, now residing in *Barnsboro* the County of *Cambria*, and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully showeth: that

your petitioner arrived in the United States of America, to-wit: At the port of *New York*, in the State of *New York* on or about the *21* day of *December*, A. D. 1889, being then

under the age of eighteen years, to-wit: of the age of *seventeen* years, that he has resided within the limits and jurisdiction of the United States for five years last past, and for one year last past within the State of Pennsylvania; and that during more than three years last past, it has been his intention to become a citizen of the United States: that he has never borne any hereditary title, or been of any of the orders of nobility in *Austria*, from whence he came.

He therefore prays that he may become a citizen of the United States, and he will ever pray, &c.
