Lloyd they being duly sworn according to law do depose and say, That they met E.B. Alsop the party who signed the foregoing contract at his office in Room No 201 National Bank of Commerce Building, Cor. 6th Ave and Wood street, Pittsburg Penna on Thursday the 27th day of June A.D. 1901 and then and there the above contract was produced to him by ~~George~~ M. Harshbarger the party named in said contract who is to purchase the said land, and the said E.B. Alsop did then and there acknowledge the said contract to be his act and that the signature thereto was in his own proper handwriting, That on the same day to wit the 27th day of June A.D. 1901 about 11 A.M. in the office of the said E.B. Alsop as aforesaid the above named ~~George~~ M. Harshbarger by his attorney in our presence and in the presence of each other and in the presence of and to the said E.B. Alsop did make a tender and did hand to and count to the said E.B. Alsop the sum of Thirty five thousand dollars in legal tender notes of the lawful money of the United States of America or so much of the said Thirty five thousand dollars as would be necessary to pay for the land of the said South Fork Club as contained in said contract at the rate of Fifty dollars per acre and that he did demand of the said E.B.
