Dear Father

I have delayed writing
to you until got the Havana
Trade closed Capt Cooper is

he got somewhat off the handle

so far as we can learn. When

your stock. It is not a Ballman
Co & hence you will not see
quotations in Ball's paper & it is

York. next week & raise some
money on it for do not sell
Don't think will sell for as much
