April 13 1864

I take the present opportunity
of writing a few lines to
let you know that I am
well I am still in Richmond
This is a very wet day
last night was very
heavy rain and to
day is a little cold
we all feel lost. for
want of letters since
the mail has stopped
coming I think it will
soon get fixed up so
that we will get our
letters We have the
Duty pretty steady
but not so hard as pocket
Duty Still I felt as
safe on the pocket line
as I do here

I am still on guard
at this old Seersucker
and would just trust
them as far as I could
see them still they are
civil enough to me
I have no trouble now
I won't put my self
to much bother for
them.

I think that we
will get home before
long I don't think
that there will
be any more fighting
General Lee and Johnston
has surrendered
Our Regiment had the
first Colours in Richmond
there was some men in

in before our Regiment
but no Organized
Regiment I have not
much to write about
there is not much
particular going on
here all is quiet
