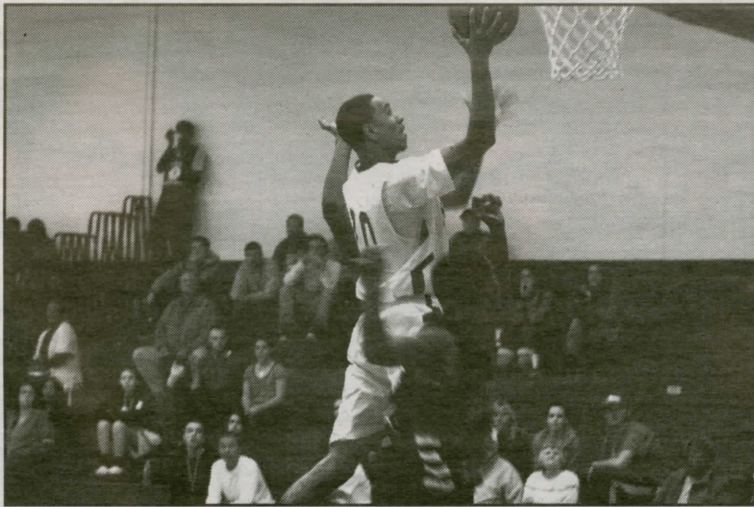

Success on the Court

In their inaugural season, the Montgomery County Community College Mustangs men's basketball team finished 18-8 overall and 16-4 in the Eastern Pennsylvania Collegiate Conference (EPCC). The team placed third in the regular season EPCC standings and claimed the third place title in the EPCC Championship Final. In the 2010-11 basketball season, the Mustangs look to improve upon last season's performance with strong returning players and new incoming talent.

Returning players Kenny Walton (Germantown) and Adam Jones (North Penn) are expected to lead this year's squad in the front and back court. Last year Walton earned a solid 144 points and 98 rebounds, while Jones racked up 98 rebounds and led the team in points with 249.

Norristown High School will contribute a number of alumni to the 2010-11 Mustangs roster, including freshmen Bryant Baylis and Louie Frangiosa and sophomore Jarrell Gardner. Newcomers Nick Roman and Ryan Francis, both from Cheltenham will add to the depth of the Mustangs' pool of guards, while freshmen North Penn alumni Ryan Getson and Brian Rooney will help the team as forwards.

This season's Mustangs squad will also have some extra height with the addition of 6'6" freshman Marcus Langley (Phila. E&T), 6'7" sophomore Dan Drennan (Bishop McDevitt) and 6'8" freshman Patrick Morris (Ft. White).

The Mustangs team will be rounded out by sophomore guard Xavier Shaw of Del Val Charter and freshman guard Justin Nixon of Math, Civics & Science.

Head Coach Denny Surovec is confident in his team and looks forward to working with returning assistant coaches Darby Callahan and Jon Palmer in his third season with the Mustangs.
