Renovations of the Brendlinger Library at the Central Campus have been completed. Students, teachers and librarians report enjoying the renewed quiet the end of construction brings to College Hall. The third floor library looks different but has many of the same materials as before – books, reference materials and periodicals. New to the third floor are group study rooms for students to reserve. Checkout has been moved to the second floor.

The renovations to the second floor showcase expanded study areas for students, the audio-visual library, classrooms for reference librarians, a children's book corner and a sleek yet-to-be-named café

with a window-seat view of the bustling College Hall atrium.

Now open for business, the café looks promising as a new hot spot for students to get their caffeine fix with a banana nut muffin on the side, and catch up on homework or to stop procrastinating and study for the upcoming test.

Additionally, the library plans to continue its virtual and visual exhibits programs. There is currently an exhibit on display in the alcove with the flat screen TV and glass display case diagonal to the librarian and desk checkout desks.
