E-courses and online learning programs will also be available. The University Center is conveniently located to routes 100 and 422 and the Pottstown business district.

Housed in an old Reading Railroad depot at Hanover Street and South Street, the building is significant in Pottstown's history because it exemplifies the development of modern industrial architecture. Built in the 1920s by The Reading Company, the building handled freight and passenger trains for Reading and Conrail until 1976. The East Penn Motor Club bought the building in 1986. It is designated an historic building and is part of the Pottstown walking tour.
