Wickersham Family

Thomas Wickersham, pioneer ancestor of the Wickersham family of Chester Co., Pa., came to America about the year 1700 from Bolney, Sussex County, England, bringing with him a certificate from the monthly meeting of the Society of Friends held at Horsham, Sussex County, England, 9-17-1700. He settled on a large tract of land in East Marlborough Twp., Chester Co., Pa., where he died in 1730. He m. (1st) Ann, by whom insofar as the records show he had no children; m. (2nd) in England, Alice Hogg.

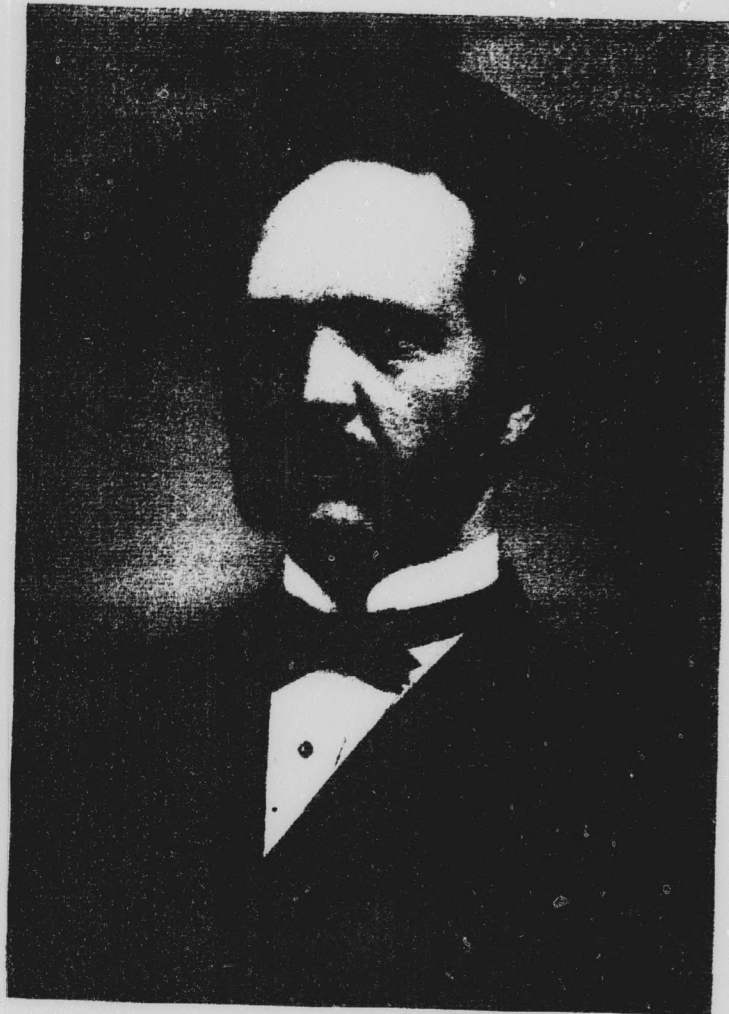
